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5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
6 following:

7 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 19.27 RCW
8 to read as follows:

9 The building code council shall adopt rules by December 1, 1991,
10 requiring that all buildings classed as E-1 occupancies, as defined in
11 the state building code, except portable school classrooms, constructed
12 after the effective date of this act, be provided with an automatic
13 fire-extinguishing system. Rules adopted by the council shall consider
14 applicable nationally recognized fire and building code standards and
15 local conditions.

16 By December 15, 1991, the council shall transmit to the
17 superintendent of public instruction, the state board of education, and
18 the fire protection policy board copies of the rules as adopted. The
19 superintendent of public instruction, the state board of education, and
20 the fire protection policy board shall respond to the council by
21 February 15, 1992, with any recommended changes to the rule. If
22 changes are recommended the council shall immediately consider those
23 changes to the rules through its rule-making procedures. The rules
24 shall be effective on July 1, 1992."

25 "**Sec. 2.** RCW 48.48.045 and 1986 c 266 s 69 are each amended to
26 read as follows:

1 Nonconstruction standards (~~((for construction))~~) relative to fire
2 prevention and safety for all schools under the jurisdiction of the
3 superintendent of public instruction and state board of education shall
4 be established by the state fire protection board. (~~((The director of
5 community development, through the director of fire protection, shall
6 adopt such nationally recognized fire and building codes and standards
7 as may be applicable to local conditions. After the approval of such
8 standards by the superintendent of public instruction and the state
9 board of education, the director of community development, through))~~)
10 The director of fire protection(~~((7))~~) shall make or cause to be made
11 plan reviews and construction inspections for all E-1 occupancies as
12 may be necessary to insure compliance with (~~((said codes))~~) the state
13 building code and standards for schools adopted under chapter 19.27
14 RCW. Nothing in this section prohibits the director of fire protection
15 from delegating construction inspection authority to any local
16 jurisdiction.

17 (~~((Political subdivisions of the state having and enforcing such
18 fire and building codes and standards at least equal to or higher than
19 those adopted as provided for in this section shall be exempted from
20 the plan review and construction inspection provisions of this section
21 within their respective subdivision for as long as such codes and
22 standards are enforced.))~~)"
