

1 **SSB 5395** - H AMDS TO H COMM STRIKING AMENDMENT **638 ADOPTED**

5 On page 120, line 15 of the striking amendment, strike  
6 "\$22,000" and insert "\$2,022,000"

7 On page 120, line 17 of the striking amendment, after  
8 "limitations:" strike "The" and insert "(1) \$22,000 of the"

9 On page 120, line 19 of the striking amendment, after  
10 "prevention." insert the following:

11 "(2)(a) The legislature finds that state school feeding  
12 programs are essential to the health and well-being of many  
13 children and that continuing these programs during a teachers' work  
14 stoppage is in the best interests of the state of Washington.

15 The legislature intends to continue to provide food to  
16 eligible children during the teachers' work stoppage, which began  
17 on April 18, 1991, in forty-six districts throughout the state.

18 (b) \$2,000,000 of the appropriation, of as much thereof as  
19 may be necessary, is provided solely to replace federal funding for  
20 breakfasts and lunches that the state is not eligible to receive  
21 because of the teachers' work stoppage.

22 (c) The superintendent of public instruction may reimburse  
23 school districts with state funds from the appropriation provided

1 in this subsection (2) for the amount of any unavailable federal  
2 share of funds for breakfasts or lunches actually provided to  
3 children during the teachers' work stoppage that began April 18,  
4 1991."

EFFECT: Provides \$2,000,000 GFS for lunches and breakfasts provided to children during the teachers' work stoppage to replace lost federal funds due to the stoppage.
