5 On page 29, after line 10 of the amendment, insert the following:

6 "Sec. 10. RCW 18.29.045 and 1991 c 3 s 47 are each amended to read
7 as follows:

8 An applicant holding a valid license and currently engaged in
9 practice in another state may be granted a license without examination
10 required by this chapter, on the payment of any required fees, if the
11 secretary in consultation with the advisory committee determines that
12 the other state's licensing standards, including those related to the
13 administration of legend drugs, are substantively equivalent to the
14 standards in this state(~~(:—PROVIDED,—That))~~). The secretary in
15 consultation with the advisory committee may require the applicant to:
16 (1) File with the secretary documentation certifying the applicant is
17 licensed to practice in another state; and (2) provide information as
18 the secretary deems necessary pertaining to the conditions and criteria
19 of the uniform disciplinary act, chapter 18.130 RCW and to demonstrate
20 to the secretary a knowledge of Washington law pertaining to the
21 practice of dental hygiene."

22 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 11.** A new section is added to chapter 18.29
23 RCW to read as follows:

24 (1) The department shall issue a temporary license without the
25 examination required by this chapter to any applicant who, as
26 determined by the secretary:

1 (a) Holds a valid license in another state that allows the scope of
2 practice in subsection (3)(a) through (j) of this section;

3 (b) Is currently engaged in active practice in another state. For
4 the purposes of this section, "active practice" means five hundred
5 sixty hours of practice in the preceding thirty months;

6 (c) Files with the secretary documentation certifying that the
7 applicant:

8 (i) Has graduated from an accredited dental hygiene school approved
9 by the secretary;

10 (ii) Has successfully completed the dental hygiene national board
11 examination; and

12 (iii) Is licensed to practice in another state;

13 (d) Provides information as the secretary deems necessary
14 pertaining to the conditions and criteria of the uniform disciplinary
15 act, chapter 18.130 RCW;

16 (e) Demonstrates to the secretary a knowledge of Washington state
17 law pertaining to the practice of dental hygiene, including the
18 administration of legend drugs;

19 (f) Pays any required fees; and

20 (g) Meets requirements for AIDS education.

21 (2) The term of the temporary license issued under this section is
22 eighteen months and it is nonrenewable.

23 (3) A person practicing with a temporary license granted under this
24 section has the authority to perform hygiene procedures that are
25 limited to:

26 (a) Oral inspection and measuring of periodontal pockets;

27 (b) Patient education in oral hygiene;

28 (c) Taking intra-oral and extra-oral radiographs;

29 (d) Applying topical preventive or prophylactic agents;

30 (e) Polishing and smoothing restorations;

- 1 (f) Oral prophylaxis and removal of deposits and stains from the
2 surface of the teeth;
- 3 (g) Recording health histories;
- 4 (h) Taking and recording blood pressure and vital signs;
- 5 (i) Performing subgingival and supragingival scaling; and
- 6 (j) Root planing.

7 (4) A person practicing with a temporary license granted under this
8 section may not perform the following dental hygiene procedures:

- 9 (a) Give injections of local anesthetic or administer nitrous
10 oxide/oxygen analgesia;
- 11 (b) Place restorations into the cavity prepared by a licensed
12 dentist and afterwards carve, contour, and adjust contacts and
13 reclusion of the restoration; or
- 14 (c) Soft tissue curettage."

15 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 12. Section 11 of this act shall take effect
16 on July 1, 1992."

17 Renumber the sections consecutively and correct any internal
18 references accordingly.
