6 following:

7 "Sec. 1. RCW 67.28.210 and 1991 c 331 s 3 are each amended to read
8 as follows:

9 All taxes levied and collected under RCW 67.28.180, (~~67.28.230,~~)
10 67.28.240, and 67.28.260 shall be credited to a special fund in the
11 treasury of the county or city imposing such tax. Such taxes shall be
12 levied only for the purpose of paying all or any part of the cost of
13 acquisition, construction, or operating of stadium facilities,
14 convention center facilities, performing arts center facilities, and/or
15 visual arts center facilities or to pay or secure the payment of all or
16 any portion of general obligation bonds or revenue bonds issued for
17 such purpose or purposes under this chapter, or to pay for advertising,
18 publicizing, or otherwise distributing information for the purpose of
19 attracting visitors and encouraging tourist expansion when a county or
20 city has imposed such tax for such purpose, or as one of the purposes
21 hereunder, and until withdrawn for use, the moneys accumulated in such
22 fund or funds may be invested in interest bearing securities by the
23 county or city treasurer in any manner authorized by law. In addition
24 such taxes may be used to develop strategies to expand tourism:
25 PROVIDED, That any county, and any city within a county, bordering upon
26 Grays Harbor may use the proceeds of such taxes for construction and
27 maintenance of a movable tall ships tourist attraction in cooperation
28 with a tall ships restoration society, except to the extent that such

1 proceeds are used for payment of principal and interest on debt
2 incurred prior to June 11, 1986: PROVIDED FURTHER, That any city or
3 county may use the proceeds of such taxes for the refurbishing and
4 operation of a steam railway for tourism promotion purposes: PROVIDED
5 FURTHER, That any city bordering on the Pacific Ocean with a population
6 of not less than one thousand and the county in which such a city is
7 located may use the proceeds of such taxes for funding special events
8 or festivals, or promotional infrastructures including but not limited
9 to an ocean beach boardwalk."
