- the following: "Affordable farmworker housing is essential to the

- 8 WHEREAS, The need for affordable farmworker housing is estimated to
- be at least twenty-five thousand units; and 9
- WHEREAS, The need for affordable farmworker housing is not 10
- 11 currently being met due to the costs associated with constructing the
- 12 housing; and
- WHEREAS, The need for affordable farmworker housing will not be met 13
- 14 without economic incentives;
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Senate of the state of
- 16 Washington, the House of Representatives concurring, That a committee
- for affordable farmworker housing be created, composed of fifteen 17
- members as follows: Two members of the senate, one from each of the 18
- 19 major caucuses, who are appointed by the president of the senate; two
- members of the house of representatives, one from each of the major 20
- 21 caucuses, who are appointed by the speaker of the house of
- 22 representatives; the chair of the state building code council, or
- designee; and ten additional members selected by the president of the 23
- 24 senate and the speaker of the house of representatives, including: Two
- 25 representatives of the agricultural community involved in providing
- 26 farmworker housing; two farmworker representatives; two representatives
- 27 of the building industry, one from eastern Washington and one from
- western Washington; a representative of residential architecture and 28
- 29 design professionals; one representative of private nonprofit

- 1 farmworker housing organizations; one representative of cities; and one
- 2 representative of counties; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the following shall be advisory,
- 4 nonvoting members of the committee: The director of the department of
- 5 community development, or designee; the director of the department of
- 6 labor and industries, or designee; the secretary of health, or
- 7 designee; a member of the state board of health, appointed by the chair
- 8 of the state board of health; the commissioner of the employment
- 9 security department, or designee; and the director of the state energy
- 10 office, or designee; and
- 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That there shall be no reimbursement to
- 12 nonlegislative committee members for committee activities; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the committee shall explore all
- 14 aspects of the cost associated with constructing farmworker housing and
- 15 shall seek to find methods of reducing costs by any available means
- 16 while maintaining adequate health and safety standards. In studying
- 17 the issue, the committee shall, at a minimum, examine the potential
- 18 benefits of modifying construction and thermal performance standards
- 19 for seasonally occupied housing, and the effect of establishing an
- 20 energy rebate program for seasonal housing constructed according to
- 21 model standards; and
- 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the committee shall also explore
- 23 financing techniques that can be used for the construction or
- 24 rehabilitation of seasonally or year-round occupied farmworker housing;
- 25 and
- 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the committee may seek assistance from
- 27 appropriate state or federal agencies; and
- 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the committee shall report its
- 29 findings and recommendations to the legislature by December 31, 1992;
- 30 and

- 1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the committee shall be terminated
- 2 January 10, 1993."
