5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
6 following:

7 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that school
8 districts and educational service districts are funded primarily
9 through state dollars, that state funds are to be used in the most
10 efficient manner, that all travel expenses paid with state dollars
11 should be treated similarly, and that the benefits of the preferred
12 rates obtained by the state of Washington from various suppliers for
13 travel expenses should extend to all travel expenses funded by state
14 dollars."

15 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 28A.310
16 RCW to read as follows:

17 Any educational service district in this state may charge all
18 travel expenses incurred by its employees and board of director members
19 during official travel which is funded by state dollars and is
20 authorized under the rules and regulations of the respective
21 educational service district to the office of the superintendent of
22 public instruction and obtain the benefit of the state of Washington
23 preferred rates for travel expenses. Upon submittal of a travel
24 voucher which establishes that the employee or board member will use or
25 has used the supplier providing the state-preferred rate by an
26 educational service district to the office of the superintendent of
27 public instruction, the office of the superintendent of public

1 instruction shall pay such travel expenses at the state-preferred rate.
2 The office of the superintendent of public instruction shall bill the
3 educational service district for the expenses paid and the educational
4 service district shall reimburse the office of the superintendent of
5 public instruction for all such expenses paid."

6 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.400
7 RCW to read as follows:

8 Any school district in this state may charge all travel expenses
9 incurred by its employees and board of director members during official
10 travel which is funded by state dollars and is authorized under the
11 rules and regulations of the respective school district to the office
12 of the superintendent of public instruction and obtain the benefit of
13 the state of Washington preferred rates for travel expenses. Upon
14 submittal of a travel voucher which establishes that the employee or
15 board member will use or has used the supplier providing the state-
16 preferred rate by a school district to the office of the superintendent
17 of public instruction, the office of the superintendent of public
18 instruction shall pay such travel expenses at the state-preferred rate.
19 The office of the superintendent of public instruction shall bill the
20 school district for the expenses paid and the school district shall
21 reimburse the office of the superintendent of public instruction for
22 all such expenses paid."

23 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 43.19 RCW
24 to read as follows:

25 The state of Washington, through the department of general
26 administration, is authorized and directed to take all reasonable and
27 necessary action to include educational service districts and school
28 districts as direct beneficiaries of any contract negotiated by the

1 state of Washington for preferred rates regarding travel, lodging, and
2 subsistence."

3 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. Sections 2 and 3 of this act shall
4 expire December 31, 1991."

5 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 6. Sections 2 and 3 of this act shall not
6 have the effect of impairing any contractual rights in effect as of the
7 effective date of this act."

8 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 7. If any provision of this act or its
9 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
10 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
11 persons or circumstances is not affected."
