7 "Sec. 1. RCW 24.03.405 and 1987 c 117 s 5 are each amended to read
8 as follows:

9 The secretary of state shall charge and collect for:

10 (1) Filing articles of incorporation (~~and issuing a certificate of~~
11 ~~incorporation, twenty~~) or an application for reinstatement under RCW
12 24.03.386, thirty dollars.

13 (2) Filing articles of amendment or restatement (~~and issuing a~~
14 ~~certificate of amendment or a restated certificate of incorporation,~~
15 ~~ten~~) or an amendment or supplement to an application for
16 reinstatement, twenty dollars.

17 (3) Filing articles of merger or consolidation (~~and issuing a~~
18 ~~certificate of merger or consolidation, ten~~), twenty dollars.

19 (4) Filing a statement of change of address of registered office or
20 change of registered agent, or revocation, resignation, (~~affidavit of~~
21 ~~nonappointment,~~) or any combination of these, (~~five~~) ten dollars. A
22 separate fee for filing such statement shall not be charged if the
23 statement appears in an amendment to articles of incorporation or in
24 conjunction with the filing of the annual report.

25 (5) Filing articles of dissolution, no fee.

26 (6) Filing an application of a foreign corporation for a
27 certificate of authority to conduct affairs in this state (~~and issuing~~
28 ~~a certificate of authority, twenty~~), thirty dollars.

1 (7) Filing an application of a foreign corporation for an amended
2 certificate of authority to conduct affairs in this state (~~(and issuing~~
3 ~~an amended certificate of authority, ten)~~), twenty dollars.

4 (8) Filing an application for withdrawal of a foreign corporation
5 and issuing a certificate of withdrawal, no fee.

6 (9) Filing a certificate by a foreign corporation of the
7 appointment of a registered agent, (~~(five)~~) ten dollars. A separate
8 fee for filing such certificate shall not be charged if the statement
9 appears in conjunction with the filing of the annual report.

10 (10) Filing a certificate of election adopting the provisions of
11 chapter 24.03 RCW, twenty dollars.

12 (11) Filing an application to reserve a corporate name, (~~(ten)~~)
13 twenty dollars.

14 (12) Filing a notice of transfer of a reserved corporate name,
15 (~~(five)~~) twenty dollars.

16 (13) Filing a name registration, twenty dollars per year, or part
17 thereof.

18 (14) Filing an annual report of a domestic or foreign corporation,
19 (~~(five)~~) ten dollars.

20 (15) Filing any other statement or report authorized for filing
21 under this chapter, ten dollars."

22 "Sec. 2. RCW 24.06.450 and 1982 c 35 s 154 are each amended to
23 read as follows:

24 The secretary of state shall charge and collect for:

25 (1) Filing articles of incorporation (~~(and issuing a certificate of~~
26 ~~incorporation, twenty)~~), thirty dollars.

27 (2) Filing articles of amendment or restatement (~~(and issuing a~~
28 ~~certificate of amendment or a restated certificate of authority, ten)~~)
29 , twenty dollars.

1 (3) Filing articles of merger or consolidation (~~and issuing a~~
2 ~~certificate of merger or consolidation, ten~~), twenty dollars.

3 (4) Filing a statement of change of address of registered office or
4 change of registered agent, or revocation, resignation, (~~affidavit of~~
5 ~~nonappointment,~~) or any combination of these, (~~five~~) ten dollars. A
6 separate fee for filing such statement shall not be charged if the
7 statement appears in an amendment to the articles of incorporation or
8 in conjunction with the annual report.

16 (8) Filing a copy of an amendment to the articles of incorporation
17 of a foreign corporation holding a certificate of authority to conduct
18 affairs in this state, (~~ten~~) twenty dollars.

19 (9) Filing a copy of articles of merger of a foreign corporation
20 holding a certificate of authority to conduct affairs in this state,
21 (~~ten~~) twenty dollars.

22 (10) Filing an application for withdrawal of a foreign corporation
23 and issuing a certificate of withdrawal, no fee.

24 (11) Filing a certificate by a foreign corporation of the
25 appointment of a registered agent, (~~five~~) ten dollars. A separate
26 fee for filing such certificate shall not be charged if the statement
27 appears in an amendment to the articles of incorporation or in
28 conjunction with the annual report.

29 (12) Filing a certificate by a foreign corporation of the
30 revocation of the appointment of a registered agent, (~~five~~) ten

1 dollars. A separate fee for filing such certificate shall not be
2 charged if the statement appears in an amendment to the articles of
3 incorporation or in conjunction with the annual report.

4 (13) Filing an application to reserve a corporate name, (~~ten~~)
5 twenty dollars.

6 (14) Filing a notice of transfer of a reserved corporate name,
7 (~~five~~) twenty dollars.

8 (15) Filing any other statement or report, including an annual
9 report, of a domestic or foreign corporation, (~~five~~) ten dollars."

10 "Sec. 3. RCW 24.03.388 and 1987 c 117 s 2 are each amended to read
11 as follows:

12 (1) An application processing fee (~~of twenty-five dollars~~) as
13 provided in RCW 24.03.405 shall be charged for an application for
14 reinstatement under RCW 24.03.386.

15 (2) An application processing fee (~~of ten dollars~~) as provided in
16 RCW 24.03.405 shall be charged for each amendment or supplement to an
17 application for reinstatement.

18 (3) The corporation seeking reinstatement shall file all annual
19 reports and pay the full amount of all annual corporation fees which
20 would have been assessed for the years of the period of administrative
21 revocation, had the corporation been in active status, including the
22 reinstatement year."

23 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. This act is necessary for the immediate
24 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
25 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
26 effect on July 1, 1991."

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4 On page 1, line 1 of the title, after "fees;" strike the remainder
5 of the title and insert "amending RCW 24.03.405, 24.06.450, and
6 24.03.388; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency."
