5 On page 25, after line 14 of the amendment, insert the
6 following:

7 "Sec. 15. RCW 82.14.340 and 1990 2nd ex.s. c 1 s 901 are each
8 amended to read as follows:

9 The legislative authority of any county with a population of
10 two hundred thousand or more, and any other county with a
11 population of one hundred fifty thousand or more that has had its
12 population increase by at least twenty-four percent during the
13 preceding nine years, as certified by the office of financial
14 management for the first day of April of each year, may and, if
15 requested by resolution of the governing bodies of cities in the
16 county with an aggregate population equal to or greater than fifty
17 percent of the total population of the county, as last determined
18 by the office of financial management, shall submit an authorizing
19 proposition to the voters of the county and if approved by a
20 majority of persons voting, fix and impose a sales and use tax in
21 accordance with the terms of this chapter.

22 The tax authorized in this section shall be in addition to any
23 other taxes authorized by law and shall be collected from those
24 persons who are taxable by the state pursuant to chapters 82.08 and
25 82.12 RCW upon the occurrence of any taxable event within such

1 county. The rate of tax shall equal one-tenth of one percent of
2 the selling price (in the case of a sales tax) or value of the
3 article used (in the case of a use tax).

4 When distributing moneys collected under this section, the
5 state treasurer shall distribute ten percent of the moneys to the
6 county in which the tax was collected. The remainder of the moneys
7 collected under this section shall be distributed to the county and
8 the cities within the county ratably based on population as last
9 determined by the office of financial management. In making the
10 distribution based on population, the county shall receive that
11 proportion that the unincorporated population of the county bears
12 to the total population of the county and each city shall receive
13 that proportion that the city incorporated population bears to the
14 total county population.

15 Moneys received from any tax imposed under this section shall
16 be expended exclusively for criminal justice purposes and shall not
17 be used to replace or supplant existing funding. Moneys received
18 by the county and the cities within the county from any tax imposed
19 under this section may be expended for domestic violence community
20 advocates, as defined in RCW 70.123.020, if, prior to the effective
21 date of this section and prior to approval of the voters, the
22 legislative authority of the county, which submitted an authorizing
23 proposition to the voters of the county, adopted by ordinance a
24 financial plan that included expenditure of a portion of the moneys
25 received for domestic violence community advocates.

26 This section expires January 1, 1994."
