5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
6 following:

7 "Sec. 1. RCW 41.04.230 and 1988 c 107 s 19 are each amended to
8 read as follows:

9 Any official of the state authorized to disburse funds in payment
10 of salaries and wages of public officers or employees is authorized,
11 upon written request of the officer or employee, to deduct from the
12 salaries or wages of the officers or employees, the amount or amounts
13 of subscription payments, premiums, contributions, or continuation
14 thereof, for payment of the following:

15 (1) Credit union deductions(~~(: PROVIDED, That the credit union is~~
16 ~~organized solely for public employees: AND PROVIDED FURTHER, That~~
17 ~~twenty-five or more employees of a single state agency or a total of~~
18 ~~one hundred or more state employees of several agencies have authorized~~
19 ~~such a deduction for payment to the same credit union)).~~

20 (2) Parking fee deductions: PROVIDED, That payment is made for
21 parking facilities furnished by the agency or by the department of
22 general administration.

23 (3) U.S. savings bond deductions: PROVIDED, That a person within
24 the particular agency shall be appointed to act as trustee. The
25 trustee will receive all contributions; purchase and deliver all bond
26 certificates; and keep such records and furnish such bond or security
27 as will render full accountability for all bond contributions.

1 (4) Board, lodging or uniform deductions when such board, lodging
2 and uniforms are furnished by the state, or deductions for academic
3 tuitions or fees or scholarship contributions payable to the employing
4 institution.

5 (5) Dues and other fees deductions: PROVIDED, That the deduction is
6 for payment of membership dues to any professional organization formed
7 primarily for public employees or college and university professors:
8 AND PROVIDED, FURTHER, That twenty-five or more employees of a single
9 state agency, or a total of one hundred or more state employees of
10 several agencies have authorized such a deduction for payment to the
11 same professional organization.

12 (6) Labor or employee organization dues may be deducted in the
13 event that a payroll deduction is not provided under a collective
14 bargaining agreement under the provisions of RCW 41.06.150: PROVIDED,
15 That twenty-five or more officers or employees of a single agency, or
16 a total of one hundred or more officers or employees of several
17 agencies have authorized such a deduction for payment to the same labor
18 or employee organization: PROVIDED, FURTHER, That labor or employee
19 organizations with five hundred or more members in state government may
20 have payroll deduction for employee benefit programs.

21 (7) Voluntary deductions for political committees duly registered
22 with the public disclosure commission and/or the federal election
23 commission: PROVIDED, That twenty-five or more officers or employees
24 of a single agency or a total of one hundred or more officers or
25 employees of several agencies have authorized such a deduction for
26 payment to the same political committee.

27 (8) Insurance contributions to the authority for payment of
28 premiums under contracts authorized by the state health care authority.

29 (9) Deductions to a bank, savings bank, or savings and loan
30 association if the bank, savings bank, or savings and loan association

1 is authorized to do business in this state and deductions to it are
2 authorized.

3 Deductions from salaries and wages of public officers and employees
4 other than those enumerated in this section or by other law, may be
5 authorized by the director of financial management for purposes clearly
6 related to state employment or goals and objectives of the agency and
7 for plans authorized by the state health care authority.

8 The authority to make deductions from the salaries and wages of
9 public officers and employees as provided for in this section shall be
10 in addition to such other authority as may be provided by law:
11 PROVIDED, That the state or any department, division, or separate
12 agency of the state shall not be liable to any insurance carrier or
13 contractor for the failure to make or transmit any such deduction."

14 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 41.04 RCW
15 to read as follows:

16 Any official of any local political subdivision of the state,
17 municipal corporation, or quasi-municipal corporation authorized to
18 disburse funds in payment of salaries and wages of employees is
19 authorized upon written request of any employee, to deduct all or part
20 of such employee's salary or wages for payment to any bank, savings
21 bank, credit union, or savings and loan association if the bank,
22 savings bank, credit union, or savings and loan association is
23 authorized to do business in this state."

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27 On page 1, line 1 of the title, after "deductions;" strike the
28 remainder of the title and insert "amending RCW 41.04.230; and adding

1 a new section to chapter 41.04 RCW."
