8 (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to willfully disobey the order of the chief administrative officer of a public school district 9 10 or approved private school, or of an authorized designee of any such administrator, to leave any motor vehicle, building, grounds or other 11 property which is owned, operated or controlled by the school district 12 13 or approved private school if the person so ordered is under the 14 influence of alcohol or drugs, or is committing, threatens to 15 imminently commit or incites another to imminently commit any act which 16 would disturb or interfere with or obstruct any lawful task, function, process or procedure of the school district or approved private school 17 18 or any lawful task, function, process or procedure of any student, official, employee or invitee of the school district or approved 19 20 private school. The order of a school officer or designee acting 21 pursuant to this subsection shall be valid if the officer or designee reasonably believes a person ordered to leave is under the influence of 22 23 alcohol or drugs, is committing acts, or is creating a disturbance as 24 provided in this subsection.

25 (2) It shall be unlawful for any person to refuse to leave public 26 property immediately adjacent to a building, grounds or property which 27 is owned, operated or controlled by a school district <u>or approved</u> 28 <u>private school</u> when ordered to do so by a law enforcement officer if

such person is engaging in conduct which creates a substantial risk of
 causing injury to any person, or substantial harm to property, or such
 conduct amounts to disorderly conduct under RCW 9A.84.030.

4 (3) It shall be unlawful for any person to interfere with school
5 activities. Interfering with school activities means conduct committed
6 while school is in session and the person is on public premises
7 adjacent to or on the grounds of any public or approved private school
8 and the person:

9 (a) Makes any noise or diversion that disturbs or tends to disturb 10 the peace or good order of a school session or a class or a school 11 session and the person is requested to leave by a school authority; or 12 (b) Fails to leave the premises or immediate vicinity of the public or approved private school while the school is in session at the 13 14 request of a school authority if the person is committing, threatens to 15 commit, or is initiating the commission by another of an act that would disrupt, impair, interfere with, or obstruct the lawful mission, 16 17 process, procedures, or functions of the public or approved private 18 school.

19 (4) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit or penalize activity consisting of the lawful exercise of freedom of 20 speech, freedom of press and the right to peaceably assemble and 21 petition the government for a redress of grievances: PROVIDED, That 22 such activity neither does or threatens imminently to materially 23 24 disturb or interfere with or obstruct any lawful task, function, process or procedure of the school district, or any lawful task, 25 function, process or procedure of any student, official, employee or 26 invitee of the school district: PROVIDED FURTHER, That such activity 27 is not conducted in violation of a prohibition or limitation lawfully 28 29 imposed by the school district upon entry or use of any motor vehicle,
