(2) The requirement to register under subsection (1) of thissection does not apply to any of the following persons:

(a) A sheriff, deputy sheriff, marshall, constable, or governmentemployee who is acting in the course of employment;

(b) An attorney or the attorney's employees, who are not serving

17 (c) A person who is court appointed to serve the court's process; 18 (d) An employee of a person who is registered under this section; 19 (e) A person who does not receive a fee or wage for serving 20 process."

21 "<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 36.22 RCW
22 to read as follows:

(1) Each county auditor shall develop a registration process to
 register process servers required to register under section 1 of this
 act.

(2) The county auditor may collect an annual registration fee fromthe process server not to exceed ten dollars.

1 (3) The office of the administrator for the courts shall develop a 2 registration form for the county auditors to use in the registration 3 process for the purpose of identifying and locating the registrant, 4 including the process server's name, birthdate, and social security 5 number, and the process server's business name, business address, and 6 business telephone number.

7 (4) The county auditor shall maintain a register of process servers 8 and assign a number to each registrant. Upon renewal of the 9 registration as required in section 3 of this act, the auditor shall 10 continue to assign the same registration number. A successor entity 11 composed of one or more registrants shall be permitted to transfer one 12 or more registration numbers to the new entity."

13 "<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. A process server required to register under section 1 of this act must renew the registration within one year 14 of the date of the initial registration or when the registrant changes 15 16 his or her name, the name of his or her business, business address, or 17 business telephone number, whichever occurs sooner. If the renewal is 18 required because of a change in the information identifying the process 19 server, the process server must renew the registration within ten days of the date the identifying information changes. The process server 20 shall pay the registration fee upon renewal." 21

22 "<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. (1) A process server required to 23 register under section 1 of this act shall indicate the process 24 server's registration number and the process server's county of 25 registration on any proof of service the process server signs.

26 (2) Employees of a process server required to register under 27 section 1 of this act shall indicate the employer's registration number

1 and the employer's county of registration on any proof of service the 2 registrant's employee signs."

3 "<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 5. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) 4 of this section, any person who is otherwise entitled to collect the 5 costs of service of process shall not be entitled to collect those 6 costs if the person does not use a process server who under this 7 chapter either is required to register or is exempt from the 8 registration requirement.

9 (2) The person may collect the costs of the service of process if 10 the process server registers within forty-five days after serving the 11 process.

12 (3) This section shall apply to all process served on or after13 August 1, 1992."

14 "<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 6. Sections 1 and 3 through 5 of this act 15 shall constitute a new chapter in Title 18 RCW."

16 "<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 7. Nothing in this act modifies Superior 17 Court Civil Rule 4."
