6 "Sec. 2. RCW 28B.10.025 and 1990 c 33 s 557 are each amended to
7 read as follows:

8 (1) The Washington state arts commission shall, in consultation
9 with the governing boards ((of regents)) of the University of
10 Washington ((and)), Washington State University ((and with the boards
11 of trustees of)), the regional universities, The Evergreen State
12 College, and the community and technical colleges ((districts)),
13 determine the amount to be made available for the purchases of art
14 under RCW 28B.10.027, and payment therefor shall be made in accordance
15 with law. The designation of projects and sites, the selection,
16 contracting, purchase, commissioning, reviewing of design, execution
17 and placement, acceptance, maintenance, and sale, exchange, or
18 disposition of works of art shall be the responsibility of the
19 Washington state arts commission in consultation and in partnership
20 with the governing board ((of regents or trustees)). However, the
21 governing board shall approve the final selection of the work of art,
22 and shall formally accept the work before the commission shall proceed
23 with its installation.

24 (2) When selecting the works of art, the commission and each board
25 shall attempt to ensure that the art is in harmony with the role and
26 mission of the institution, attempt to utilize expertise available at
27 the institution, and consult a broad range of persons who are
28 interested in the institution. Such persons may include, but need not

1 be limited to faculty, staff, students, artists, administrators,
2 members of the local community, and alumni.

3 (3) The costs to carry out the Washington state arts commission's
4 responsibility for maintenance shall not be funded from the moneys
5 referred to under this section, RCW 43.17.200, 43.19.455, or
6 28A.335.210, but shall be contingent upon adequate appropriations being
7 made for that purpose."

8 "Sec. 3. RCW 28B.10.027 and 1983 c 204 s 9 are each amended to
9 read as follows:

10 All universities and colleges shall allocate as a nondeductible
11 item, out of any moneys appropriated for the original construction or
12 any major renovation or remodel work exceeding two hundred thousand
13 dollars of any building, an amount of one-half of one percent of the
14 appropriation to be expended by the Washington state arts commission
15 with the formal written approval of the institutional governing board
16 ((of regents or trustees)) for the acquisition of works of art.
17 However, before the commission installs a work of art, the governing
18 board shall approve its selection and shall formally accept the work.
19 The works of art may be placed on public lands of institutions of
20 higher education, integral to or attached to a public building or
21 structure of institutions of higher education, detached within or
22 outside a public building or structure of institutions of higher
23 education, part of a portable exhibition or collection, part of a
24 temporary exhibition, or loaned or exhibited in other public
25 facilities.

26 In addition to the cost of the works of art the one-half of one
27 percent of the appropriation shall be used to provide for the
28 administration of the visual arts program by the Washington state arts
29 commission and all costs for installation of the work of art. For the

1 purpose of this section building shall not include sheds, warehouses,
2 and other buildings of a temporary nature."
