6 following:

7 "Sec. 1. RCW 43.08.250 and 1985 c 57 s 27 are each amended to read
8 as follows:

9 The money received by the state treasurer from fees, fines,
10 forfeitures, penalties, reimbursements or assessments, except for those
11 fees, fines, forfeitures, penalties, reimbursements or assessments
12 identified in section 2 of this act, by any court organized under Title
13 3 or 35 RCW, or chapter 2.08 RCW, shall be deposited in the public
14 safety and education account which is hereby created in the state
15 treasury. The legislature shall appropriate the funds in the account
16 to promote ((~~traffic safety education, highway safety,~~)) criminal
17 justice training, crime victims' compensation, judicial education, the
18 judicial information system, winter recreation parking, and state game
19 programs. All earnings of investments of balances in the public safety
20 and education account shall be credited to the general fund."

21 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 43.08 RCW
22 to read as follows:

23 (1) The money received by the state treasurer from fees, fines,
24 forfeitures, penalties, reimbursements, or assessments from: (a)
25 Traffic infractions pertaining to the operation or condition of a
26 commercial or noncommercial vehicle whether it is moving, standing, or
27 stopping; (b) pedestrian infractions; (c) violations of RCW 46.61.502

1 or 46.61.504; and (d) all other violations listed as exceptions to RCW
2 46.63.020 pertaining to the operation or use of a vehicle, by any court
3 organized under Title 3 or 35 RCW, or chapter 2.08 RCW, shall be
4 deposited as follows: Seventy-five percent in the traffic safety and
5 enforcement account hereby created in the transportation fund and
6 twenty-five percent in the driver education account hereby created in
7 the general fund.

8 (2) Moneys in the traffic safety and enforcement account shall be
9 used for promotion of traffic safety education, highway safety, the
10 safety education officer program, commercial vehicle enforcement, and
11 other programs related to driver and vehicle safety, enforcement, and
12 administration. All earnings of investments of balances in the traffic
13 safety and enforcement account shall be credited to the transportation
14 fund, notwithstanding RCW 43.84.090.

15 (3) Moneys in the driver education account shall be used for driver
16 education programs administered by the superintendent of public
17 instruction. All earnings of investments of balances in the driver
18 education account shall be credited to the general fund."

19 "Sec. 3. RCW 43.84.090 and 1990 2nd ex.s. c 1 s 203 are each
20 amended to read as follows:

21 Except as otherwise provided by RCW 43.250.030, 67.40.025, ((and))
22 82.14.050, and section 2(2) of this act, twenty percent of all income
23 received from such investments shall be deposited in the state general
24 fund."
