5 On page 24, line 5 of the striking amendment, after "26." insert
6 the following:

7 "(1) During the twelve-month period preceding the expiration of any
8 state elected official's or state legislator's term in office, no
9 incumbent to that office may personally make a public service
10 announcement for which public funds are paid. A violation of this
11 section constitutes use of the facilities of a public office for the
12 purpose of assisting a campaign under RCW 42.17.130.

13 (2) If, during the twelve-month period preceding the expiration of
14 any state elected official's or state legislator's term in office, an
15 incumbent to that office or a candidate for that office makes a public
16 service announcement free of charge or for less than full
17 consideration, the opportunity to make such less announcement shall be
18 considered a "contribution" for the purposes of chapter 42.17 RCW to
19 the extent that less than full consideration was paid.

20 For the purposes of this section, the term "public service
21 announcement" means an announcement which promotes the programs,
22 activities or services of federal, state or local governments or the
23 programs, activities or services of nonprofit organizations or any
24 other announcements regarded as serving community interests.
