- 18 $((\frac{e}{e}))$ Any air gun, including any air pistol or air rifle,
- 19 designed to propel a BB, pellet, or other projectile by the discharge
- 20 of compressed air, carbon dioxide, or other gas.
- 21 (2) It is unlawful for any person to carry any firearm into a
- 22 public or private elementary or secondary school building.
- 23 (3) It is unlawful for any person to carry any firearm onto public
- 24 or private elementary or secondary school grounds outside of school
- 25 <u>buildings</u>.
- 26 (4) It is unlawful for an elementary or secondary school student
- 27 under the age of twenty-one to knowingly carry onto public or private
- 28 elementary or secondary school premises any firearm.
