5 On page 3, after line 20, insert the following:

6 "Sec. 3. RCW 66.28.220 and 1989 c 271 s 231 are each amended to
7 read as follows:

8 The board shall adopt rules requiring retail licensees to affix
9 appropriate identification on all containers of four gallons or more of
10 malt liquor for the purpose of tracing the purchasers of such
11 containers. The rules may provide for identification to be done on a
12 state-wide basis or on the basis of smaller geographical areas.

13 The board shall develop and make available forms for the
14 declaration and receipt required by RCW 66.28.200. The board may
15 charge class E licensees for the costs of providing the forms and that
16 money collected for the forms shall be deposited into the liquor
17 revolving fund for use by the board, without further appropriation, to
18 continue to administer the cost of the keg registration program.

19 It is unlawful for any person to sell or offer for sale kegs or
20 other containers containing four gallons or more of malt liquor to
21 consumers who are not licensed under chapter 66.24 RCW if the kegs or
22 containers are not identified in compliance with rules adopted by the
23 board."
