- 19 Longshoreman's and Harbor Worker's Act, 33 U.S.C. Secs. 901 through
- 20 950, and to explore and evaluate various delivery systems for that
- 21 reinsurance including purchase of the reinsurance by the Washington
- 22 state industrial insurance fund
- 23 (a) on it's own behalf pursuant to a program of issuance of
- 24 direct insurance, or
