Background: The state government operates on the basis of a fiscal biennium that begins on July 1 of each odd-numbered year, supported by a biennial appropriations act. Supplemental appropriations may be required to meet additional demands arising after adoption of the original budget act.

Effective Date: The bills contains an emergency clause and takes effect immediately.
