- 1 AN ACT Relating to label information for over-the-counter
- 2 medications; adding a new section to chapter 69.60 RCW; creating new
- 3 sections; and providing an effective date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that printed
- 6 material on labels and notices packaged with nonprescription drugs may
- 7 be difficult to read. This difficulty presents a potential danger to
- 8 the health and safety of customers, therefore, every effort should be
- 9 made to print these materials in a manner that makes them more
- 10 comprehensible.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 69.60 RCW
- 12 to read as follows:

- 1 No over-the-counter medication may be manufactured or commercially
- 2 distributed within this state unless the label meets requirements
- 3 established by the board to assure readability and clarity of label
- 4 information.
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The board of pharmacy shall evaluate the
- 6 labeling of over-the-counter drugs for readability and clarity of label
- 7 information. By January 1, 1992, the board shall adopt rules to take
- 8 effect January 1, 1993, establishing minimum requirements for label
- 9 information for over-the-counter medications.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** Section 2 of this act shall take effect
- 11 January 1, 1993.
