1 AN ACT Relating to tuition waivers for state employees at state
2 institutions of higher education; and amending RCW 28B.15.558.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28B.15.558 and 1990 c 88 s 1 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 (1) The governing boards of state institutions of higher education
7 as defined in RCW 28B.10.016 may waive the tuition and services and
8 activities fees for state employees as defined under subsection (2) of
9 this section pursuant to the following conditions:

10 (a) Such state employees shall register for and be enrolled in
11 courses on a space available basis and no new course sections shall be
12 created as a result of the registration;

13 (b) Enrollment information on state employees registered pursuant
14 to this section shall be maintained separately from other enrollment

1 information and shall not be included in official enrollment reports,
2 nor shall such state employees be considered in any enrollment
3 statistics which would affect budgetary determinations; and

4 (c) State employees registering on a space available basis shall be
5 charged a registration fee of not less than five dollars.

6 (2) For the purposes of this section, "state employees" means
7 permanent full-time employees in classified service under chapters
8 28B.16 and 41.06 RCW and the officers of the Washington state patrol.
