SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 1112

- 1 AN ACT Relating to environmental interpretation in Washington's
- 2 state parks; adding new sections to chapter 43.51 RCW; and creating a
- 3 new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that the lands owned
- 6 and managed by the state parks and recreation commission are a
- 7 significant collection of valuable natural, historical, and cultural
- 8 resources for the citizens of Washington state. The legislature
- 9 further finds that if citizens understand and appreciate the state park
- 10 ecological resources, they will come to appreciate and understand the
- 11 ecosystems and natural resources throughout the state. Therefore, the
- 12 state parks and recreation commission may increase the use of its

- 1 facilities and resources to provide environmental interpretation
- 2 throughout the state parks system.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The state parks and recreation commission
- 4 may provide environmental interpretative activities for visitors to
- 5 state parks that:
- 6 (1) Explain the functions, history, and cultural aspects of
- 7 ecosystems;
- 8 (2) Explain the relationship between human needs, human behaviors,
- 9 and attitudes and the environment; and
- 10 (3) Offer experiences and information to increase citizen
- 11 appreciation and stewardship of the environment and its multiple uses.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The state parks and recreation commission
- 13 may consult and enter into agreements with and solicit assistance from
- 14 private sector organizations and other governmental agencies that are
- 15 interested in conserving and interpreting Washington's environment.
- 16 NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. Sections 2 and 3 of this act are each added
- 17 to chapter 43.51 RCW.
