1            AN ACT Relating to oil transmission lines; adding a new section to  
2 Title 35 RCW; adding a new section to Title 35A RCW; adding a new  
3 section to Title 36 RCW; and creating a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.**            The legislature finds that oil  
6 transmission lines can be harmful to the public welfare and that it is  
7 in the best interest of the state to have oil transmission lines  
8 conform to local zoning and environmental codes.

9            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 2.**            A new section is added to Title 35 RCW to  
10 read as follows:

11            Oil transmission lines shall conform to all city, town, municipal,  
12 and county zoning and environmental codes.

1        NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 3.**    A new section is added to Title 35A RCW to  
2 read as follows:

3        Oil transmission lines shall conform to all city, town, municipal,  
4 and county zoning and environmental codes.

5        NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 4.**    A new section is added to Title 36 RCW to  
6 read as follows:

7        Oil transmission lines shall conform to all city, town, municipal,  
8 and county zoning and environmental codes.
