## HOUSE BILL 1251

AN ACT Relating to oil transmission lines; adding a new section to Title 35 RCW; adding a new section to Title 35A RCW; adding a new section to Title 36 RCW; and creating a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. The legislature finds that oil 6 transmission lines can be harmful to the public welfare and that it is 7 in the best interest of the state to have oil transmission lines 8 conform to local zoning and environmental codes.

9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to Title 35 RCW to 10 read as follows:

Oil transmission lines shall conform to all city, town, municipal, and county zoning and environmental codes.

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. A new section is added to Title 35A RCW to
read as follows:

3 Oil transmission lines shall conform to all city, town, municipal,4 and county zoning and environmental codes.

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. A new section is added to Title 36 RCW to 6 read as follows:

Oil transmission lines shall conform to all city, town, municipal,and county zoning and environmental codes.
