1 AN ACT Relating to licensing out-of-state cosmetologists, barbers,
2 and manicurists; amending RCW 18.16.130; and declaring an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.16.130 and 1984 c 208 s 11 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 Any person who is properly licensed in any state, territory, or
7 possession of the United States, or a foreign country shall be ((issued
8 a license under this chapter without)) eligible for examination if the
9 applicant submits the approved application fee and provides proof to
10 the director that he or she is currently licensed in good standing as
11 a cosmetologist, barber, manicurist, or the equivalent in that
12 jurisdiction ((and has completed a course of training equivalent to
13 that required under this chapter)). If the person passes the required
14 examination, the director shall issue the appropriate license.

1 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate
2 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
3 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
4 effect immediately.
