- 1 AN ACT Relating to management and enhancement of Hood Canal salmon
- 2 resources; adding new sections to chapter 75.28 RCW; and creating new
- 3 sections.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The optimum management of Hood Canal
- 6 salmon stocks is necessary in order to restore salmon runs and provide
- 7 for a successful recreational and commercial fishery. The department
- 8 of fisheries shall place special emphasis on conservation measures
- 9 which will restore all salmon resources in Hood Canal, with particular
- 10 emphasis on chinook and coho salmon stocks.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A Hood Canal commercial salmon fishing
- 12 permit is required of all licensed commercial fishers who fish in Hood
- 13 Canal. The fee for the Hood Canal commercial salmon fishing permit is
- 14 one hundred dollars annually. The director shall issue a maximum of

- 1 two hundred fifty Hood Canal commercial salmon fishing permits for gill
- 2 net fishers annually and a maximum of thirty Hood Canal commercial
- 3 salmon fishing permits for purse seine fishers annually.
- 4 The Hood Canal commercial salmon fishing permit is required in
- 5 addition to a valid commercial fishing license in order to commercially
- 6 fish Hood Canal waters for salmon.
- 7 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. Enforcement of commercial salmon fishing
- 8 rules shall be emphasized in Hood Canal commercial fisheries. The
- 9 department shall increase its program of fisheries patrol on Hood Canal
- 10 waters in order to achieve a higher level of compliance with department
- 11 rules.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** The department shall expand its use of
- 13 observers on Hood Canal commercial fishing boats for the primary
- 14 purpose of documenting the bycatch of immature chinook salmon, coho
- 15 salmon, and game fish in commercial fisheries. The department shall
- 16 develop a data base on where, when, and under what conditions
- 17 significant numbers of immature chinook salmon, coho salmon, and game
- 18 fish are captured in Hood Canal commercial fisheries.
- 19 The department shall manage the commercial fisheries in such a
- 20 manner as to minimize the capture of salmon or game fish which are
- 21 important to the recreational fisheries of Hood Canal.
- 22 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** Commercial fisheries shall be limited in
- 23 Hood Canal to areas where important recreational fisheries do not
- 24 exist. The department shall seek to conduct the majority of commercial
- 25 fisheries in the northern portion of Hood Canal.
- 26 Commercial fishing gear shall not be used in Hood Canal areas
- 27 shallower than one hundred feet in depth at mean lower low water.

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- 1 Commercial fishing gear shall not be used within five hundred yards of
- 2 the shoreline in Hood Canal.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** The director shall limit the types of
- 4 commercial fishing gear used in Hood Canal commercial fisheries in
- 5 order to minimize the bycatch of fish that are important to the
- 6 recreational fishery. Restrictions on mesh size, length, depth, and
- 7 other construction of commercial gear are to be considered based on
- 8 data that result from section 4 of this act, as well as other research
- 9 information available to the department.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 7.** The director shall investigate the
- 11 potential for enhancement projects designed to increase the abundance
- 12 and availability of Hood Canal blackmouth or immature chinook salmon
- 13 for the recreational fishery. Use of earthen rearing ponds such as the
- 14 formerly successful Percival Cove project, shall be fully investigated.
- The director shall develop an action plan for enhancement of the
- 16 recreational blackmouth fishery in Hood Canal, and shall present such
- 17 report to the legislature on or before December 31, 1991. Included in
- 18 the report shall be draft legislation designed to accomplish
- 19 enhancement of the Hood Canal blackmouth recreational fishery.
- 20 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 8.** Sections 2 through 6 of this act are
- 21 each added to chapter 75.28 RCW.
