- 1 AN ACT Relating to teacher education; and adding a new section to
- 2 chapter 28A.305 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.305
- 5 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Beginning September 1, 1992, in addition to any other approval
- 7 requirements for teacher preparation programs pursuant to RCW
- 8 28A.305.130(1), the state board of education shall require that the
- 9 general knowledge required of all candidates for teacher certification
- 10 include the skills and knowledge necessary to effectively teach and
- 11 work with students from diverse racial and ethnic populations.
- 12 (2) By October 1, 1993, each teacher preparation program in the
- 13 state shall submit to the state board of education a summary of the
- 14 actions the program has taken to ensure that its students will have the
- 15 knowledge and skills necessary to effectively teach and work with

- 1 students from diverse racial and ethnic populations. The state board
- 2 of education shall synthesize these summaries, and submit a report to
- 3 the senate and house education committees of the legislature by
- 4 December 15, 1993.
