1 AN ACT Relating to maintaining the Washington state patrol crime 2 laboratory system; creating a new section; and declaring an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. The Washington state patrol shall
maintain crime laboratories in at least the same locations as it did as
of December 31, 1990, and shall provide services at each of those
locations during the biennium beginning July 1, 1991.

8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate 9 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the 10 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take 11 effect immediately.
