- 1 AN ACT Relating to the medical disciplinary board; amending RCW
- 2 18.71.019; and adding a new section to chapter 18.71 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 18.71 RCW
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 The medical disciplinary board shall not deny, limit, fail to renew
- 7 a physician's license, or take other disciplinary action against a
- 8 licensed physician in this state for professional incompetence on the
- 9 basis that the licensee's practice or prescribed treatment of a patient
- 10 is unconventional, investigational, or innovative medical practice
- 11 without a factual finding of demonstrable harm to the patient because
- 12 of that practice or treatment. The board shall make a finding of
- 13 professional incompetence under this section only upon substantial
- 14 evidence of demonstrable harm existing in the board's official record
- 15 of proceedings under RCW 18.71.060.

- 2 as follows:
- 3 The uniform disciplinary act, chapter 18.130 RCW, governs
- 4 unlicensed practice and the issuance and denial of licenses under this
- 5 chapter, subject to the terms of section 1 of this act.
