- 1 AN ACT Relating to ocean resources information; and adding a new
- 2 section to chapter 43.143 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.143 RCW
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) The state of Washington is hereby authorized to participate
- 7 with the states of Alaska, Hawaii, Oregon, and California in a joint
- 8 liaison program with the center for ocean analysis and prediction of
- 9 the national oceanic and atmospheric administration, with the objective
- 10 of assisting the states in taking maximum advantage of the
- 11 oceanographic data, products, and services available from the federal
- 12 government through the center for ocean analysis and prediction.
- 13 (2) The liaison program shall:

- 1 (a) Assist state and local governments to become fully aware of
- 2 oceanographic data and products available from the federal government
- 3 and especially from the center for ocean analysis and prediction;
- 4 (b) Assist the center for ocean analysis and prediction and the
- 5 national oceanic and atmospheric administration to become more fully
- 6 aware of state and local problems and the requirements of state and
- 7 local governments; and
- 8 (c) Assist in setting up lines of communications to move
- 9 oceanographic data and products from the center for ocean analysis and
- 10 prediction to the people in the states who need those data and
- 11 products.
- 12 (3) The liaison program shall include workshops for small groups of
- 13 technical experts from state and local governments, academic
- 14 institutions, and the private sector. The workshops shall be held at
- 15 the center for ocean analysis and prediction in Monterey, California
- 16 and at other facilities in the western states as appropriate.
- 17 (4) This section shall not become operative until at least one
- 18 other state participates in the joint liaison program.
- 19 (5) The department of ecology and the department of natural
- 20 resources shall be the state representatives in the liaison program.
