AN ACT Relating to port districts; adding a new section to chapter 14.07 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 14.08 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 14.12 RCW; and adding a new section to chapter 53.08 RCW.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 14.07 RCW 7 to read as follows:

8 The initial use of land located in a city or town by a port 9 district for airport runway purposes, and the expansion of an existing 10 airport runway located in the city or town by a port district, are 11 subject to potential land use controls by the city or town. The 12 initial use of land located in the unincorporated area of a county by 13 a port district for airport runway purposes, and the expansion of an 14 existing airport runway located in the unincorporated area of a county,

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1 are subject to potential land use controls by the county. Once an 2 airport runway has been established pursuant to the county's, city's, 3 or town's land use controls, the county, city, or town may not adopt 4 new limitations on or prohibit such use for the land unless the land is 5 not in actual use as an airport runway for a continuous five-year 6 period.

NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 14.08 RCW
8 to read as follows:

9 The initial use of land located in a city or town by a port district for airport runway purposes, and the expansion of an existing 10 airport runway located in the city or town by a port district, are 11 subject to potential land use controls by the city or town. 12 The 13 initial use of land located in the unincorporated area of a county by a port district for airport runway purposes, and the expansion of an 14 existing airport runway located in the unincorporated area of a county, 15 16 are subject to potential land use controls by the county. Once an airport runway has been established pursuant to the county's, city's or 17 18 town's land use controls, the county, city or town may not adopt new 19 limitations on or prohibit such use for the land unless the land is not in actual use as an airport runway for a continuous five-year period. 20

21 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 14.12 RCW 22 to read as follows:

The initial use of land located in a city or town by a port district for airport runway purposes, and the expansion of an existing airport runway located in the city or town by a port district, are subject to potential land use controls by the city or town. The initial use of land located in the unincorporated area of a county by a port district for airport runway purposes, and the expansion of an

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existing airport runway located in the unincorporated area of a county, are subject to potential land use controls by the county. Once an airport runway has been established pursuant to the county's, city's, or town's land use controls, the county, city, or town may not adopt new limitations on or prohibit such use for the land unless the land is not in actual use as an airport runway for a continuous five-year period.

8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. A new section is added to chapter 53.08 RCW 9 to read as follows:

10 The initial use of land located in a city or town by a port district for airport runway purposes, and the expansion of an existing 11 airport runway located in the city or town by a port district, are 12 13 subject to potential land use controls by the city or town. The 14 initial use of land located in the unincorporated area of a county by a port district for airport runway purposes, and the expansion of an 15 16 existing airport runway located in the unincorporated area of a county, 17 are subject to potential land use controls by the county. Once an 18 airport runway has been established pursuant to the county's, city's or 19 town's land use controls, the county, city or town may not adopt new limitations on or prohibit such use for the land unless the land is not 20 in actual use as an airport runway for a continuous five-year period. 21
