- 1 AN ACT Relating to the measure of damages to a motor vehicle; and
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 4.56 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 4.56 RCW
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 In an action seeking damages for property damage to a motor
- 7 vehicle, the measure of damages is the reasonable cost of repair or the
- 8 difference between the value of the vehicle immediately before the
- 9 damage occurred and the value after the damage occurred, plus a
- 10 reasonable amount of damages for loss of use of the vehicle or the
- 11 amount reasonably expended on a temporary replacement vehicle of a
- 12 similar brand and in similar preaccident condition as the damaged
- 13 vehicle for all time periods during which the vehicle is not available
- 14 as a result of such damage. When the cost to repair or replace the
- 15 damaged motor vehicle exceeds the value of the vehicle immediately

- 1 before the damage occurred, damages for the loss of use of the vehicle
- 2 are limited to the amount reasonably and actually expended for a
- 3 temporary replacement vehicle of a similar brand and in similar
- 4 preaccident condition as the damaged vehicle until the defendant has
- 5 tendered full payment of property damage.
