1 AN ACT Relating to medical examinations required by a private 2 passenger automobile insurance policy; and adding a new section to 3 chapter 48.18 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 48.18 RCW 6 to read as follows:

7 Insurers issuing private passenger automobile insurance policies shall provide that medical examinations scheduled by the insurer to 8 9 examine the medical condition of a claimant shall be scheduled with 10 qualified health care professionals as close as possible to the 11 residence of the claimant. An insurer may not issue a private 12 passenger automobile policy that requires or has the effect of requiring a claimant to attend a medical examination located in a 13 14 county other than a claimant's county of residence, except when health 15 care professionals qualified to conduct the examination are not

1 available within the claimant's county of residence.
