1 AN ACT Relating to an exemption from retail sales tax and use tax
2 on glucose monitoring equipment; amending RCW 82.08.0283 and
3 82.12.0277; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 82.08.0283 and 1986 c 255 s 1 are each amended to read
6 as follows:

7 The tax levied by RCW 82.08.020 shall not apply to sales of
8 insulin; prosthetic and orthotic devices prescribed for an individual
9 by a person licensed under chapters 18.25, 18.57, or 18.71 RCW or
10 dispensed or fitted by a person licensed under chapter 18.35 RCW;
11 ostomic items; glucose monitoring equipment prescribed for an
12 individual by a person licensed under chapter 18.57 or 18.71 RCW that
13 is sold to an individual for an individual's use; and medically
14 prescribed oxygen.

1 **Sec. 2.** RCW 82.12.0277 and 1986 c 255 s 2 are each amended to read
2 as follows:

3 The provisions of this chapter shall not apply in respect to the
4 use of insulin; prosthetic and orthotic devices prescribed for an
5 individual by a person licensed under chapters 18.25, 18.57, or 18.71
6 RCW or dispensed or fitted by a person licensed under chapter 18.35
7 RCW; ostomic items; glucose monitoring equipment prescribed for an
8 individual by a person licensed under chapter 18.57 or 18.71 RCW for
9 use by an individual; and medically prescribed oxygen.

10 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** This act is necessary for the immediate
11 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
12 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
13 effect July 1, 1991.
