- 2 amending RCW 70.83.020.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 70.83.020 and 1975-'76 2nd ex.s. c 27 s 1 are each
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 It shall be the duty of the department of ((social and health
- 7 services)) health to require screening tests of all newborn infants
- 8 before they are discharged from the hospital for the detection of
- 9 phenylketonuria, galactosemia, and other heritable or metabolic
- 10 disorders leading to mental retardation or physical defects as defined
- 11 by the state board of health: PROVIDED, That no such tests shall be
- 12 given to any newborn infant whose parents or guardian object thereto on
- 13 the grounds that such tests conflict with their religious tenets and
- 14 practices.
