1 AN ACT Relating to the federal targeted jobs tax credit program; 2 and amending RCW 50.16.080.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 sec. 1. RCW 50.16.080 and 1988 c 84 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

(1) The cost of administering the federal targeted jobs tax credit б program shall be fully borne by the employers requesting the credits. 7 8 The commissioner shall establish the amount of the processing fee and 9 procedures for collecting the fee. <u>No fee shall apply to employers</u> with fewer than fifty employees. The commissioner shall establish the 10 processing fee at a sufficient level to defray the costs of 11 12 administering the federal targeted jobs tax credit program. The fee 13 shall be established by the commissioner by rule. However, if federal

1 funding is provided to finance such services, the commissioner shall 2 revise or eliminate this fee based on the amount of federal funding 3 received. Fees received for processing shall be deposited in a special 4 account in the unemployment compensation administration fund.

5 (2) The commissioner shall, by January 1, 1992, develop and 6 implement strategies to (a) significantly reduce the paperwork 7 associated with this program, and (b) increase by two hundred percent 8 the number of employers participating in the program.
