- 1 AN ACT Relating to the regulation of cable television on islands;
- 2 adding new sections to chapter 80.54 RCW; creating a new section;
- 3 providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that many island
- 6 residents are unable to obtain cable television at any price and that
- 7 some cable television companies refuse to provide cable services simply
- 8 because of the low resident population density of islands. The
- 9 legislature further finds that information and entertainment provided
- 10 by the cable television companies are important to the welfare of
- 11 island residents.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 80.54 RCW
- 13 to read as follows:

- 1 A cable television company offering cable television hook-ups to
- 2 one or more island residents shall offer at a reasonable cost the same
- 3 service to all island residents.
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 80.54 RCW
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Section 2 of this act shall be enforced by the commission. The
- 7 commission is hereby authorized to assess an amount sufficient to carry
- 8 out the provisions of this section upon all cable television companies
- 9 doing business in this state.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 11 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 12 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
- 13 effect July 1, 1991.
