5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 **Sec. 1.** RCW 53.16.030 and 1933 c 145 s 4 are each amended to read 7 as follows:

Any change of boundary lines provided for in this chapter shall not 8 9 affect the term for which a commissioner shall hold office at the time 10 the change is made((, and the requirement of two years' residence 11 within the commissioner district for eligibility for office of port 12 commissioner shall not apply to incumbent commissioners seeking election at any port district election held within three years of the 13 14 change of such district boundaries: PROVIDED, That at the time of 15 nomination the incumbent commissioner resides in the commissioners 1 district for which he seeks election)).
