- 6 FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION--FOR TRAFFIC SAFETY
- 7 EDUCATION PROGRAMS
- 8 Public Safety and Education Account
- 10 <u>15,721,000</u>
- 11 The appropriation in this section is subject to the following
- 12 conditions and limitations:
- 13 (1) Not more than \$596,000 may be expended for regional traffic
- 14 safety education coordinators.

- 1 (2) ((A maximum of \$2,300,000 may be expended in the 1991-92 fiscal
- 2 year and \$2,425,000 in the 1992-93 fiscal year to provide tuition
- 3 assistance for traffic safety education for students from low-income
- 4 families)) (a) A maximum of \$137.27 is provided as a subsidy for each
- 5 student receiving traffic safety education.

- 7 provided local funding prior to the effective date of this act. The
