- 1 AN ACT Relating to fire protection sprinkler systems; adding a new
- 2 section to chapter 9.45 RCW; adding new sections to chapter 18.160 RCW;
- 3 prescribing penalties; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 9.45 RCW
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Any fire protection sprinkler system contractor, defined under RCW
- 8 18.160.010, who willfully and maliciously constructs, installs, or
- 9 maintains a fire protection sprinkler system in any structure so as to
- 10 threaten the safety of any occupant or user of the structure in the
- 11 event of a fire, is guilty of a class C felony.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 18.160 RCW
- 13 to read as follows:

- 1 Any fire protection sprinkler system contractor who constructs,
- 2 installs, or maintains a fire protection sprinkler system in any
- 3 occupancy, except an owner-occupied single-family dwelling, without
- 4 first obtaining a fire sprinkler contractor's license from the state of
- 5 Washington, is guilty of a gross misdemeanor.
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 18.160 RCW
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 Civil proceedings to enforce this chapter may be brought by the
- 9 attorney general or the prosecuting attorney of any county where a
- 10 violation occurs on his or her own motion or at the request of the
- 11 state director of fire protection.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 13 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 14 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
- 15 effect immediately.
