- 6 The cemetery authority may inter or cremate any remains upon the
- 7 receipt of a written authorization of a person representing himself to
- be a person who has acquired the right to control the disposition of 8
- 9 A cemetery authority is not liable for interring or the remains.
- cremating pursuant to such authorization, unless it has actual notice 10
- 11 that such representation is untrue.
- 12 In the event the state of Washington or any of its agencies provide
- the funds for the disposition of any remains and the state or its 13
- 14 agency elects to provide the funds for cremation only, the ((cemetery

- 3 If the provisions of RCW 68.50.160 do not apply, a crematory
- 4 licensed under the provisions of RCW 68.05.175 or 18.39.217 shall have
- 5 the right to rely on a personal representative of the decedent or the
- 6 <u>decedent's estate to execute an authority to cremate, and the crematory</u>
- 7 shall not be criminally or civilly liable for cremating the remains.
