- 1 AN ACT Relating to the right of a person to control the disposition
- 2 of the person's remains; and amending RCW 68.50.160.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 68.50.160 and 1943 c 247 s 29 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 A person has the right to control the disposition of his or her own
- 7 remains without the predeath or postdeath consent of any other person.
- 8 Any valid written document expressing the decedent's wishes regarding
- 9 the disposition of his or her remains, signed by the decedent in the
- 10 presence of a witness, is sufficient legal authorization for the
- 11 procedures to be accomplished. If directions have not been given by
- 12 the decedent, the right to control the disposition of the remains of a
- 13 deceased person((, unless other directions have been given by the
- 14 decedent,)) vests in, and the duty of interment and the liability for

- 1 the reasonable cost of interment of such remains devolves upon the
- 2 following in the order named:
- 3 (1) The surviving spouse.
- 4 (2) The surviving children of the decedent.
- 5 (3) The surviving parents of the decedent.
- 6 The liability for the reasonable cost of interment devolves jointly
- 7 and severally upon all kin of the decedent hereinbefore mentioned in
- 8 the same degree of kindred and upon the estate of the decedent.
