- AN ACT Relating to guide and service dogs; amending RCW 70.84.020
- 2 and 70.84.021; and adding a new section to chapter 70.84 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 70.84.020 and 1980 c 109 s 2 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 For the purpose of this chapter, the term "guide dog" shall mean a
- 7 dog which is in working harness and is trained, in training, or
- 8 approved by an accredited school engaged in training dogs for the
- 9 purpose of guiding blind persons or a dog which is trained, in
- 10 training, or approved by an accredited school engaged in training dogs
- 11 for the purpose of assisting hearing impaired persons.
- 12 Sec. 2. RCW 70.84.021 and 1985 c 90 s 1 are each amended to read
- 13 as follows:

- 1 For the purpose of this chapter, "service dog" means a dog that is
- 2 trained, in training, or approved by an accredited school, or state
- 3 institution of higher education, engaged in training dogs for the
- 4 purposes of assisting or accommodating a physically disabled person
- 5 related to the person's physical disability.
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 70.84 RCW
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 Any guide or service dog accompanied by a trainer who is affiliated
- 9 with an accredited school shall have access to any of the places listed
- 10 in RCW 70.84.010(3).
