1 AN ACT Relating to guide and service dogs; and amending RCW 2 70.84.020 and 70.84.021.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 70.84.020 and 1980 c 109 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

For the purpose of this chapter, the term "guide dog" shall mean a dog which is in working harness and is trained, in training, or approved by an accredited school engaged in training dogs for the purpose of guiding blind persons or a dog which is trained, in training, or approved by an accredited school engaged in training dogs for the purpose of assisting hearing impaired persons.

12 Sec. 2. RCW 70.84.021 and 1985 c 90 s 1 are each amended to read 13 as follows:

p. 1 of 2

For the purpose of this chapter, "service dog" means a dog that is trained, in training, or approved by an accredited school, or state institution of higher education, engaged in training dogs for the purposes of assisting or accommodating a physically disabled person related to the person's physical disability.
