1 AN ACT Relating to funding alcohol awareness programming; and
2 creating new sections.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The Washington state liquor control
5 board is charged with the responsibility of controlling the
6 manufacture, distribution, sale, and consumption of alcoholic
7 beverages. As part of that responsibility, the board shall conduct an
8 aggressive public awareness campaign directed toward youth under the
9 legal drinking age of twenty-one years to discourage consumption of
10 alcoholic beverages.

11 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** The liquor control board shall appoint
12 an advisory committee to provide guidance to the board in developing an
13 alcohol awareness program directed toward youth under the legal

1 drinking age of twenty-one years. The board shall seek to establish a
2 balanced advisory committee with membership selected from
3 representatives of manufacturers, distributors, retailers, advertisers,
4 and consumers of alcoholic products; recognized alcohol awareness,
5 treatment, and prevention groups; social service organizations
6 providing youth services; public health officials; law enforcement
7 officials; traffic safety education officials; medical professionals
8 involved in research or treatment of alcohol related diseases or social
9 problems. At least two members of the advisory group shall be persons
10 less than twenty-one years old. The advisory group created under this
11 section shall be considered a class one group under RCW 43.03.220.
