1 AN ACT Relating to recycling vending machine product containers; 2 and adding a new section to chapter 70.95 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 70.95 RCW
to read as follows:

6 (1) Receptacles for recycling glass, aluminum, steel, or tin-coated 7 steel containers dispensed by a vending machine shall be located in the vicinity of the vending machine. The owner or operator of the vending 8 machine shall either provide and service the receptacles or may enter 9 10 into an agreement to have the receptacles provided and serviced by 11 another entity, including but not limited to, persons working in a 12 building in which a vending machine is located and nonprofit charitable organizations. 13

(2) For purposes of this section, "vending machine" means any coin operated machine that:

3 (a) Sells or provides food, tobacco, sundries, or other retail 4 merchandise in a container that is composed of more than ten percent by 5 weight of glass, aluminum, steel, or tin-coated steel; and

6 (b) Is located on a passenger ferry or in a rest area owned,7 operated, or maintained by the department of transportation.
