- 1 AN ACT Relating to ongoing absentee voter status; amending RCW
- 2 29.36.013; repealing RCW 29.36.016; and providing an effective date.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 29.36.013 and 1991 c 81 s 30 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 Any ((disabled)) voter ((or any voter over the age of sixty-five))
- 7 may apply, in writing, for status as an ongoing absentee voter. Each
- 8 ((such voter shall be granted that status by his or her county auditor
- 9 and)) qualified applicant shall automatically receive an absentee
- 10 ballot for each ensuing election for which he or she is entitled to
- 11 vote and need not submit a separate request for each election. Ballots
- 12 received from ongoing absentee voters shall be validated, processed,

13 and tabulated in the same manner as other absentee ballots.

- 1 Status as an ongoing absentee voter shall be terminated upon any of
- 2 the following events:
- 3 (1) The written request of the voter;
- 4 (2) The death or disqualification of the voter;
- 5 (3) The cancellation of the voter's registration record; or
- 6 (4) The return of an ongoing absentee ballot as undeliverable((; or
- 7 (5) January 1st of each odd-numbered year)).
- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** RCW 29.36.016 and 1985 c 273 s 3 are
- 9 each repealed.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act shall take effect July 1, 1992.
