1 AN ACT Relating to accountability and collaboration in higher
2 education and K-12 education; and adding new sections to chapter 28B.10
3 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.10 RCW
6 to read as follows:

7 The legislature finds that some college students who have recently
8 graduated from high school must immediately enroll in one or more
9 precollege classes before they can proceed successfully through
10 college. The legislature also finds that these students should have
11 received basic skills in English, reading, spelling, grammar, and
12 mathematics before graduating from high school. It is the intent of
13 the legislature that colleges and universities provide information to
14 school districts about recent graduates who enroll in precollege

1 classes. It is also the intent of the legislature to encourage
2 institutions of higher education and the common schools to work
3 together to solve problems of common concern.

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.10 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 By May 1st of each year, each institution of higher education as
7 defined in RCW 28B.10.016 shall provide a report to the office of the
8 superintendent of public instruction. The report shall contain the
9 following information: (1) The numbers of college freshmen or
10 sophomores who graduated from a Washington high school within three
11 years of enrolling in a state-supported precollege level class in
12 mathematics, reading, grammar, spelling, writing, or English; (2) the
13 types of precollege classes in which each student is enrolled; and (3)
14 the Washington high school from which each student graduated. Each
15 institution of higher education shall also report information on
16 precollege class enrollment to the Washington school district from
17 which each student enrolled in a precollege class graduated.
