- 1 AN ACT Relating to contracts let by first class cities; and
- 2 amending RCW 35.22.650.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 35.22.650 and 1975 1st ex.s. c 56 s 4 are each amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 All contracts by and between a first class city and contractors for
- 7 any public work or improvement exceeding the sum of ((ten)) twenty-five
- thousand dollars, or ((fifteen)) thirty thousand dollars 8
- 9 construction of water mains, shall contain the following clause:
- 10 "Contractor agrees that he shall actively solicit the employment of
- 11 women and minority group members. Contractor further agrees that he
- shall actively solicit bids for the subcontracting of goods or services 12
- 13 from qualified women businesses and minority businesses which are
- certified by the office of minority and women's business enterprises. 14

- 1 Contractor shall furnish evidence of his compliance with these
- 2 requirements of ((minority)) employment and solicitation. Contractor
- 3 further agrees to consider the grant of subcontracts to ((said)) the
- 4 minority bidders on the basis of substantially equal proposals in the
- 5 light most favorable to ((said)) the women businesses and minority
- 6 businesses. The contractor ((shall be)) is required to submit evidence
- 7 of compliance with this section as part of the bid."
- 8 ((As used in this section, the term "minority business" means a
- 9 business at least fifty-one percent of which is owned by minority group
- 10 members. Minority group members include, but are not limited to,
- 11 blacks, women, native Americans, Orientals, Eskimos, Aleuts, and
- 12 Spanish Americans.))
