- 1 AN ACT Relating to the sale of antifreeze; adding a new section to
- 2 chapter 70.54 RCW; prescribing penalties; and providing an effective
- 3 date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 70.54 RCW
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) No person may sell automotive antifreeze that is:
- 8 (a) Toxic;
- 9 (b) Potentially attractive to young children or domestic animals
- 10 because of its taste or odor; and
- 11 (c) Not likely to cause immediate vomiting if ingested.
- 12 (2) The secretary of health shall adopt rules establishing
- 13 standards for the sale of automotive antifreeze under this section.

- 1 (3) Selling antifreeze in violation of this section or in violation
- 2 of rules adopted pursuant to it is a misdemeanor.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act shall take effect July 1, 1992.
