- 1 AN ACT Relating to state background checks on persons providing
- 2 services to physically disabled or mentally impaired persons; amending
- 3 RCW 43.20A.710; and creating a new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.20A.710 and 1989 c 334 s 13 are each amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 The secretary shall investigate the conviction records, pending
- 8 charges or disciplinary board final decisions of: (1) Persons being
- 9 considered for state employment in positions directly responsible for
- 10 the supervision, care, or treatment of children, mentally ill persons
- 11 or developmentally disabled persons; and (2) sole independent
- 12 contractors who are paid by the state and hired by physically disabled
- 13 or mentally ill or impaired persons. The sole independent contractors
- 14 shall pay the fee charged by the state patrol for the state background

- 1 check. The investigation may include an examination of state and
- 2 national criminal identification data and the child abuse and neglect
- 3 register established under chapter 26.44 RCW. The secretary shall use
- 4 the information solely for the purpose of determining the character,
- 5 suitability, and competence of these applicants. Criminal justice
- 6 agencies shall provide the secretary such information as they may have
- 7 and that the secretary may require for such purpose. If necessary,
- 8 persons may be employed on a conditional basis pending completion of
- 9 the background investigation.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act applies prospectively only and
- 11 not retroactively.
